

# Quality Improvement Awards for New Registry Members: Frequently Asked Questions

Maine Roads to Quality Professional Development Network (MRTQ PDN) is partnering with the Maine Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Child and Family Services (DHHS, OCFS) to offer Quality Improvement Awards (QIA) to early childhood and out-of-school time practitioners in Maine. First-time Registry members who complete the requirements listed below are eligible for this one-time \$100 award. *These awards will be given on a first-come, first-served basis until funds are expended.* 

# Am I eligible for a Quality Improvement Award (QIA) for New Registry Members?

To be eligible to apply for this Quality Improvement Award you must:

Have never been a member of the Maine Roads to Quality Registry.

## The following requirements must be completed within 14 calendar days of the initial application (Step 1):

- 1. Complete the online Registry Application at <a href="https://mrtq-registry.org">https://mrtq-registry.org</a> (click "Join") between the dates of 3/1/21 and 8/31/22.
- 2. Submit all required documentation, **including documentation of educational level**, to mrtq.registry@maine.edu.
- 3. Complete the on-demand six-hour training "Health and Safety Orientation." Follow the login instructions to access this training.
- 4. Complete the online application for the Quality Improvement Award New Registry Member. The QIA award application will be available once you have logged into your Registry record at <a href="https://mrtq-registry.org">https://mrtq-registry.org</a>.
- 5. Already have or create vendor status in the University of Maine System. The form is available at: <a href="http://www.maine.edu/umsvendor">http://www.maine.edu/umsvendor</a>.

#### What is the award amount?

This is one-time award of \$100.

### Are there requirements for how the QIA can be spent?

No! These funds are awarded as a one-time payment to you to be used as you choose.


## How can I apply for a QIA?

You can log in to your Registry account at <a href="https://mrtq-registry.org">https://mrtq-registry.org</a>. If you are eligible for a QIA, you will see a green notification in the top-left corner:



The final section of the application requires your contact information, date of birth (for verifying the correct Registry account), agreeing to the Terms and Conditions, and an electronic signature. Be sure to click the green "submit" button at the bottom of the screen.





# Quality Improvement Awards for New Registry Members: Frequently Asked Questions

Please note this vital step - you must be listed as a "vendor" with the University of Southern Maine for MRTQ PDN to issue a check to you. The form is available at: <a href="http://www.maine.edu/umsvendor">http://www.maine.edu/umsvendor</a>. Contact Eric at <a href="mailto:eric.norgaard@maine.edu">eric.norgaard@maine.edu</a> or 207-780-4367 if you feel you have previously been established as a vendor in the University of Maine System. Checks cannot be processed unless this step is completed within 14 days of applying for this award!

### How and when will I receive my QIA?

Upon completion of the application and confirmation of current vendor status, MRTQ PDN will process payment requests. A check will be mailed to your mailing address within 30-45 days. ### Is there a deadline to apply for a QIA?

The program period for the QIAs ends on August 31, 2022. <u>However, these awards are first-come, first-serve and will be awarded until funds are expended.</u>
